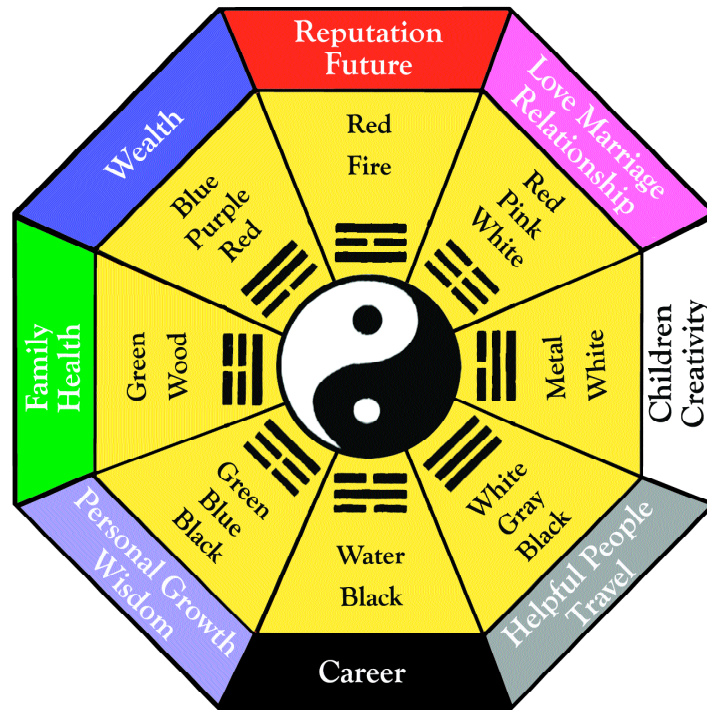

How to Use Your Feng Shui Bagua

This colorful diagram will help you understand the Feng Shui positioning of any room, home, office building, or even a plot of land. The octagonal-shaped diagram is divided into nine sections called guas, which represent nine areas of life: Prosperity, Future, Relationships, Creativity, Helpful People, Work, Knowledge, Family, and Health. It is truly a resourceful tool for understanding your space and bringing about the kinds of changes you want to make.

Feng Shui practitioners use the bagua diagram to locate which areas of a room or space relate to the different life areas listed above. Here is how it works. Go to the most frequently-used entranceway of a room and hold your bagua in your hand. Orient yourself within the space by locating the primary entranceway at the bottom of your bagua—you are standing in this area. Now let's go through each section of the bagua to see how it corresponds with the areas of your space.

The far left portion of your room or space is the wealth section; the far right portion is the marriage section; etc. Go around the entire room and see how each area corresponds to the sections on the bagua. Now, if you want to incite change in a particular area of your life, just use one or more Feng Shui "cures" I will be sharing with you.

You are going to become very familiar with your bagua and the various ways it is used in Feng Shui. Each gua is also associated with a color or colors (see diagram), and you can enhance an area of your life by adding its color(s) to the appropriate area. For example, simply place a piece of furniture, an art object, a vase of flowers, etc. that contains the color(s) indicated on the gua to enhance the area that you are working on. For instance, to increase your wealth, place a blue, purple or red object in the back left part of your room or space.

The center area of your space or room, together with four of the gua sections correspond to the five elements: fire, air, water, earth, and wood. If there is a certain aspect of your life that you wish to focus on, you can enhance it by putting something made of that area's gua element in the part of the room representing the needed change. For example, if you want to become pregnant, put a metal object in the section of your home that corresponds to children on the bagua. This will draw positive energy into that section of the room and aspect of your life.
